Many others may follow suit based on reader's aspirations and suggestions.

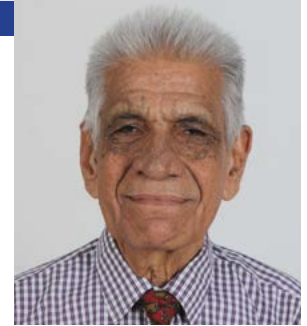

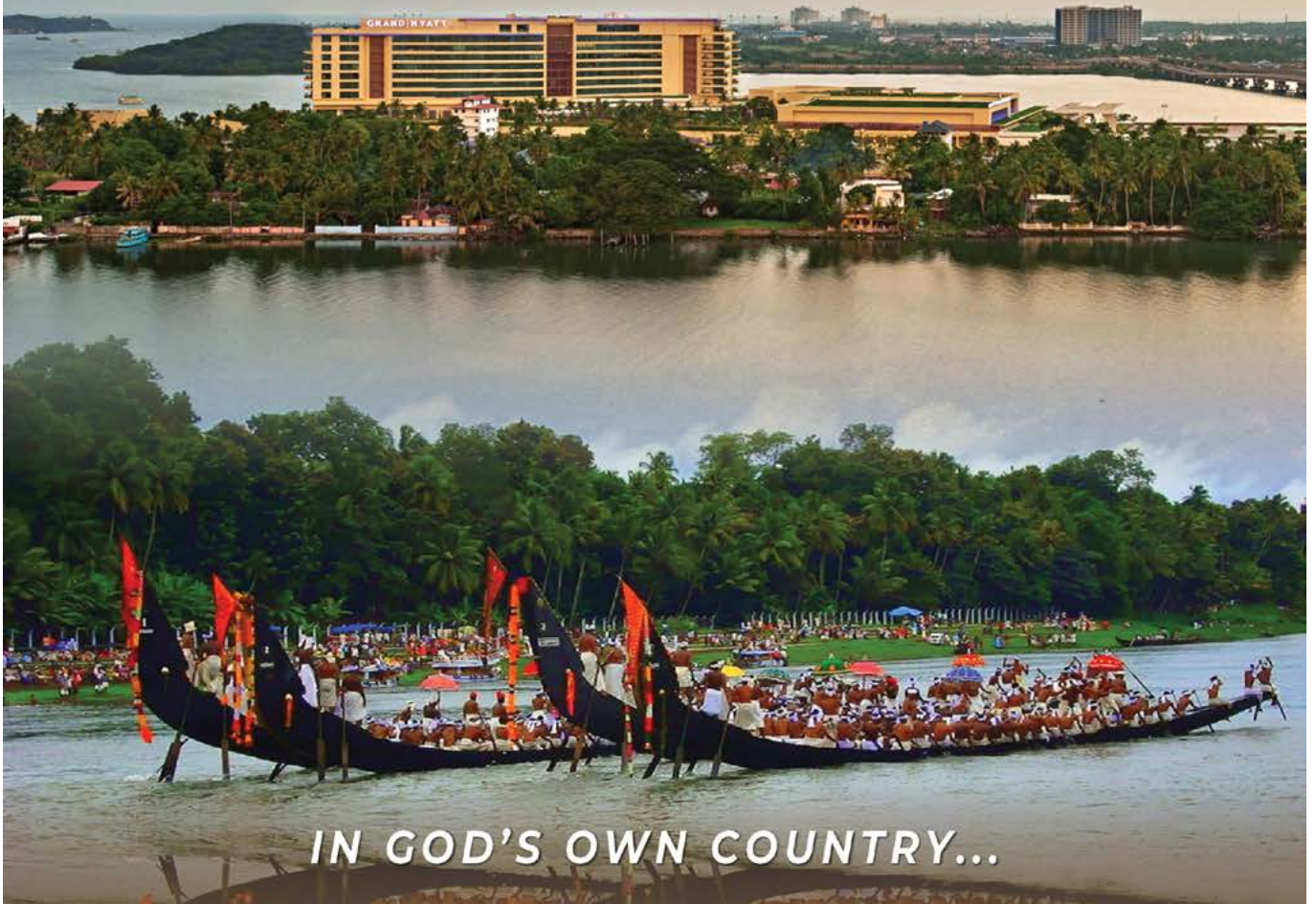

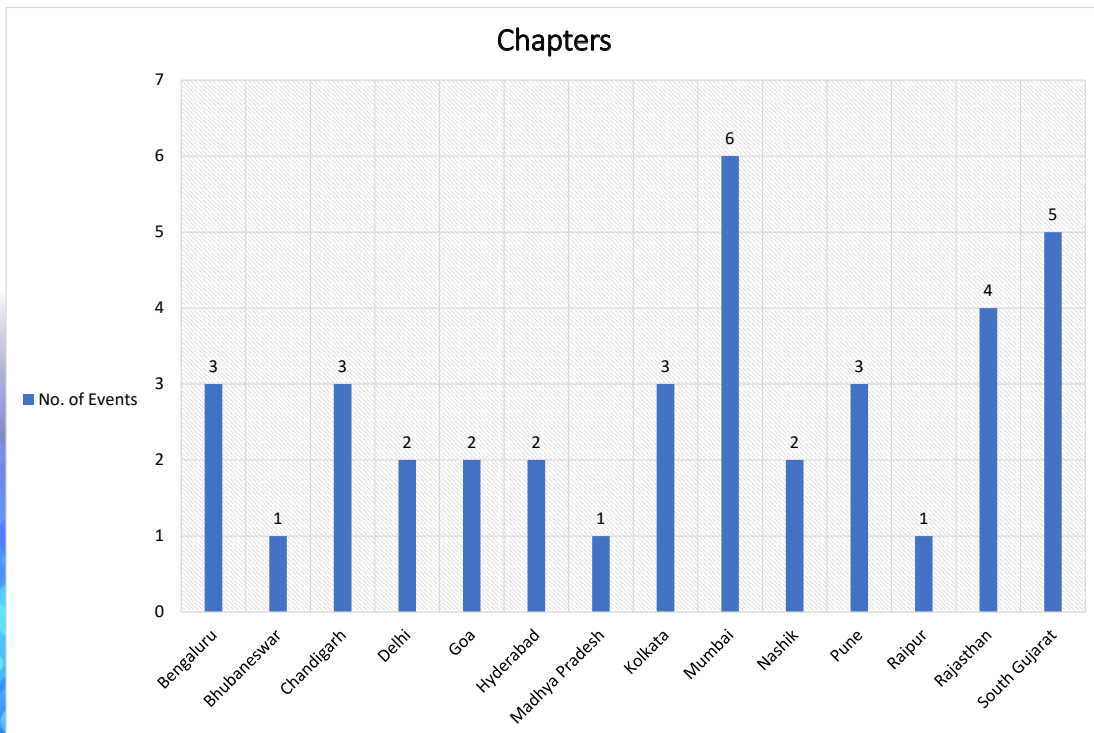
